**BEFORE ME**, The Honorable Timothy Bailey, Judge of the Circuit Court of the Seventeenth Judicial Circuit in and for Broward County, State of Florida, personally came Detective Juan Herrera, of the Broward Sheriff's Office, WHO AFTER BEING FIRST DULY SWORN and pursuant to F.S. 901.02, DEPOSES AND SAYS that on or about the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of March, A.D. 2024, in the County and State aforesaid, one **JUNIOR GENEUS BAZILE, [B/M/10/26/1994]** did then and there:

**GROUNDS FOR ISSUANCE**

The following grounds constitute this Affiant's reason for his belief that the laws of the State of Florida were violated as stated above and the facts establishing the grounds for this affidavit and the probable cause for believing that such facts exist are as follows:

**AFFIANT QUALIFICATIONS**

Your Affiant, Detective Juan Herrera, has been a sworn Law Enforcement Officer for nine years. Four of those years have been with the Broward Sheriff's Office as a Deputy Sheriff. Your affiant is currently assigned to the Airport District Criminal Investigations Unit as a Detective. In this unit, your affiant has participated in several investigations into numerous types of criminal activities including auto thefts, grand thefts, burglaries, fraud, and other property related criminal investigations. Your affiant has also completed specialized training in areas such as criminal law and Criminal Investigation's. Through such training and work experience, your affiant has obtained a reasonable insight into the techniques and methods employed by persons that are engaged in grand theft, fraud, and associated activity.

**PROBABLE CAUSE**

On 03/03/2024, the victim, [REDACTED] reported that she was schedule to leave the Fort Lauderdale-Hollywood International Airport on Spirit Airlines Flight # 1555 at approximately 6:30PM to Tampa, Florida. Spirit Airlines cancelled the flight and advised that all passengers could retrieve their checked luggage on luggage belt four of the terminal four lower level.

The victim waited for her checked luggage, which was a pink in color, hard shell roller bag, to come out of luggage belt two, but it never did. The picture below is of the victim's checked luggage.



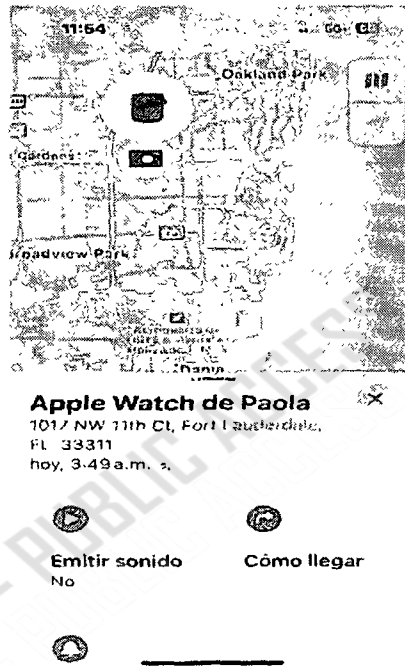

The victim provided a sworn statement and reported the following items as being within the checked luggage at the time of the theft:

- (1) MacBook SN: HXJKNGAM1WG2, (1) iPad SN: N766X64LHD. (1) Apple Watch SN: CN4492VY3X and several pieces of high-end woman's clothing and toiletries.

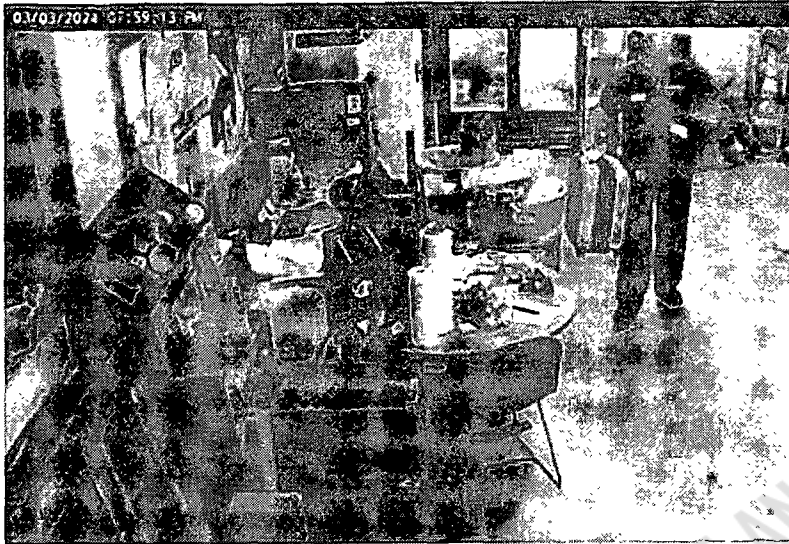
The victim later pinged the electronic items that were within the checked bag and it showed them as being located at 1017 NW 11th Ct., in Fort Lauderdale, FL 33313. The picture below is of the victim's ping.



On 03/04/2024, the victim responded to 1017 NW 11th Ct., in Fort Lauderdale, FL 33313 in order to retrieve her items. Once on scene, she could not make contact with anyone from within the home. The victim took video and still pictures of the home, while she was still on scene. The victim advised that she saw several pieces of luggage in the front of the home, but none of them were hers.

I then searched the address 1017 NW 11th Ct, Fort Lauderdale, FL 33313 through internal Fort Lauderdale-Hollywood International Airport employee data bases. I found that Junior Bazile B/M DOB: 10/26/1994 reported living at this location. Bazile works for Paradies BWD, LLC and was working on the day of the theft. Paradies BWD, LLC loss prevention manager was contacted, and he provided internal CCTV footage from the day of the incident. The footage depicts Bazile entering the Paradise BWD, LLC storage room with a pink in color, hard shell roller bag, which matched the description of the stolen luggage. The picture below depicts Bazile entering the room.

Bazile then rummages through the luggage, places the luggage underneath the desk and takes out a MacBook and other items. He then places the smaller items in a black bag and the MacBook in a clear plastic bag. The check luggage he places in a clear plastic bag. The pictures below depict Bazile retrieving the MacBook and placing the electronic items in the bags.


